We are an international jewelry design team with over 18 years of experience in designing various styles of gold jewelry, diamond jewelry, fashion and high jewelry, both for mass production and custom design based on our customers' needs.

Since 2005 we have designed over 80,000 models of jewelry for many big companies around the world in countries such as Turkey, USA, Iran, Italy, Germany, Belgium, UAE, India and Morocco.

With more than 20 in-house designers, each month we design over 700 sketches and more than 300 3D models ready for printing and manufacturing with 3D printers and casting machines.

One of the biggest issues and concerns in the jewelry industry is the "Trust" between two companies which want to be partners, especially in design, which is one of the most important steps in manufacturing. Here in MDA we assure all of our customers that all of designing materials which belongs to them will be kept with high security policies.



Our Design Process

The Design process normally depends on our customer's needs. Technically after we get familiar with our customer's style and design method, we start to making mood boards and draw rough sketches based on a "Concept" and then share it with our customers to hear their opinion. Then we finalize those rough sketches and turn them into final sketches. The final sketches demonstrate more than 90% of the manufactured jewelry.

The last step is to make the 3D model based on that sketch. In this step our 3D design team carefully make a 3D model with CAD software such as Gemvision Matrix, MatrixGold, Rhinoceros, Solidworks and ZBrush depending on the designs with taking into account all the jewelry making, diamond setting and goldsmithing standards (Also based on our customer's company standards).

We can prepare a 3D model for rubber mold making and also for direct casting method.

We can also make "support trees" for 3D models which can be printed with DLP 3D printers.

These are some of our mood boards which we made in our design atelier with our professional design team based on some of the famous styles and trends in jewelry design all over the world such as "Art Deco", "Knots", "Optical Illusion", "Facet" and "Memphis design", before starting the design process and drawing the rough sketches.







What we mean by using the term "Rough Sketch" is that we draw too many sketches in a fast and unprecise way to generate as many designs as possible in a specific time, then we choose the best ones from those rough sketches as the final ones.

In this step we share our ideas with our customers to know their opinion on the process and if they want to change something or if they have any concerns or ideas about the sketches, we will do as they wish.




















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UNEXPECTED

Long Live The Memphis

The style of the exuberant movement, which exploded at the end of the 20th century in Italy, reinterpreted through the codes of daring fine jewelry by Seyed Mohammad Mortazavi – by Antonella Reina

The encounter between jewelry and design has never been a simple matter because it involves disciplinary fields with different creative intentions: on the one hand, the rational and functional vocation of industrial production inextricably linked to a social context, while on the other, the artisan vocation aimed at defending traditional manufacturing and precious materials as synonyms of a timeless product. Things, however, change when the players in the match share the same sense of artistic freedom, opening up new creative avenues that transcend pre-established boundaries. *Unlike other jewelry designers who find Memphis an unsuitable style for fine jewelry. I think that, with the right interpretation of the forms and standards of this movement, fine and even high jewelry can be designed in this style,* explains Iranian designer Seyed Mohammad Mortazavi. Founder and CEO of MDA (Mor-

tazavi Design Academy), the largest jewelry school in Iran, Mortazavi has created three collections dedicated to Sottsass's iconic postmodernist movement. "The Memphis artists opened a new path in Italian design which was closer to American fashion and pop art, supporting free design made of exaggerated colors and shapes. These characteristics made it a potentially interesting concept for my designs." The Frame and Capsule collections are particularly striking. Here the designer proposes a series of carrings that look like precious mini robots. With their aesthetics made up of negative and positive spaces, enameled profiles, bold colors, small diamonds and large gemstones of various shapes and shades, the items create an extraordinarily communicative bridge between the revolutionary cultural phenomenon of the 1980s and the younger Gen Z audience.



Le cose, però, cambiano quando gli attori del match condividono lo stesso senso di libertà artistica, aprendo nuovi varchi creativi che travalicano i confini prestabiliti. «A differenza di altri designer di gioielli che trovano Memphis uno stile inadatto alla fine jewelry, penso che con un'interpretazione corretta delle forme e degli standard di questo movimento, si possano progettare gioielli raffinati e persino di alta gioielleria in questo stile», spiega il designer iraniano Seyed Mohammad Mortazavi. Founder e Ceo della MDA (Mortazavi Design Academy), la più grande scuola di gioielleria in Iran, Mortazavi ha creato tre collezioni dedicate all'iconico movimento postmodernista di Sottsass. «Gli artisti di Memphis hanno aperto un nuovo percorso nel design italiano più vicino alla moda e alla pop art americana, supportando il design libero, fatto di colori e forme esagerati. Tali caratteristiche lo hanno reso un potenziale concetto interessante per i miei progetti». Colpiscono particolarmente la collezione Frame e Capsule, in cui il designer propone una serie di orecchini che sembrano preziosi mini robot: con la loro estetica fatta di spazi negativi e positivi, profili smaltati, colori decisi, piccoli diamanti e grandi pietre preziose di varie forme e nuance, i pezzi creano un ponte straordinariamente comunicativo tra il rivoluzionario fenomeno culturale degli anni '80 e il pubblico più giovane della Gen Z. •
